

▶ INTRODUCTION

Digital, 3in1 Single Channel FULL HIGH DEFINITION MPEG4 modulator with 3 SELECTA-BLE modulation SIGNALS (DVB-C, DVB-T & ISDB-T). With input from any HDMI source (Terrestrial & Satellite decoders, cameras, DVD, DVR etc.) it modulates and produces selectable output by choosing one out of THREE (3) signals: DVB-C, DVB-T & ISDB-T, depending on the installation signal, with simple adjustment using the 6 buttons and the 4-digit LED display. It offers High Output Resolution up to 1080p @ 30FPS and excellent image quality. Easy and fast PLUG & PLAY installation plus rapid adjustment with the Fast Pre-Config function among 50 selectable IDs for absolute flexibility of configuration, according to three installation signals (DVB-C, DVB-T & ISDB-T) and the number of modulators in the installation.

► CONNECTION & OPERATION

- 1. Connect an HDMI cable from HDMI source device to the "HD in" of HD Modulator.
- Connect an RF coaxial cable to the "RF OUT" output for signal distribution to the RF network.
- 3. Connect the power adapter to the HD Modulator.
- Select configuration signals from the MENU TV STANDARD (STAN) between DVB-C, DVB-T or ISDB-T
- 5. Select an output frequency or channel.
- If you have more than one HD Modulator in the same installation, select a different ID for each modulator.
- 7. Proceed with channel scanning on your TV/STB.

Press the lock key once, and when the green led lights up, the keypad is locked. Press once again to unlock.



A HD SIGNAL

Connect the HDMI cable to the HD IN and, when the green led lights up, the signal is active.





► MAIN MENU

To enter the main menu options, press **once** the **Menu/OK** key and use the **Left or Right keys** to navigate within the main menu.



FR: Shows the selected RF output frequency on the DVB-C modulation cable signal. With the «Up», «Down» keys you change the selection.



CH: Shows the selected RF output channel in the DVB-T or ISDB-T terrestrial signal modulation selection. Use the "Up", "Down" keys to change the selection.



QAM: Shows the QAM in the DVB-C modulation. Use the "Up", "Down" keys to change the 16QAM, 32QAM, 64QAM, 128QAM or 256QAM selection.



ID: Shows the current ID. Use the "Up", "Down" keys to change the selection



RF: Shows the RF output level. Use the "Up", "Down" keys to change the selection



LCN: Shows the current LCN type. With the "Up", "Down" keys you can change the selection.



FACT: Factory settings. You can press the "Up" button, to select them.



CFG: Export current configuration file. You can press the "Up" key, to save it to USB stick



SOFT: Current software version. You can press the "**Up**", "**Down**" key to display it.



STAN: Shows the TV STANDARD modulation signals. Use the "Up", "Down" keys to change the DVB-C, DVB-T or ISDB-T selection.

To save the selected configuration press once the MENU/OK key and confirm with YES or NO by pressing the LEFT and RIGHT keys and press MENU/OK key once again. The configuration is being saved, please do not power off!





► CONFIGURATION EXTRACTION (CFG)

For an advanced configuration of the HD modulator, you must extract the configuration file to a USB drive, modify it and import it again in the HD modulator. To extract the configuration file named **jedi_config.txt***, you must connect a USB drive** to the USB slot, enter the **Main Menu, select**CFG and press key UP to extract the file to the USB drive. When the message

SUCC appears, the process has been successfully completed.

*IMPORTANT: The name of the configuration file jedi_config.txt should not be changed!

^{**}IMPORTANT: Use only FAT32 type. In any other case, the FAIL message will indicate the failure of the process.

► CONFIGURATION IMPORT (CFG)

To import the configuration file <code>jedi_config.txt</code>, you must save the file within the root directory* of a USB drive, insert the drive to the USB slot and power cycle your HD Modulator. When you see this message <code>CFG</code>, press the <code>MENU/OK</code> button to confirm the import process. When the process is completed, the unit will reboot with the new configuration!



*IMPORTANT: Use only FAT32 partitions. In any other case, the configuration file will not be read and the device will reboot normally!



▶ FAST PRE-CONFIG FUNCTION / 50 ID'S SELECTABLE

This feature allows the user to configure easy and fast all the signal parameters of the unit, selecting from the 50 ready and installed IDs*. This function is necessary and important when we have more than one HD Modulator in the same installation. The user must select an ID to change the parameters, so that the final devices can be tuned to the signal from the HD Modulators.

*IMPORTANT: In order to change the Channel Name, you have to use the CFG function to extract, edit and load the modified configuration file to the HD Modulator.

▶TROUBLESHOOTING

The device does not boot

- · Make sure the power supply is connected
- · Check power supply voltage

I cannot export configuration file

- · Make sure your USB drive is working
- Make sure that the file system is FAT32

I get "No signal" message on the screen

- Please check your HDMI cable or the HDMI source device
- Make sure that the HDMI signal complies with the supported standards

The channel number on the list does not appear properly

- · Make sure you have selected correct LCN type
- Make sure you have no conflicting LCN numbers


The video of the modulator appears to be from another modulator

· Make sure your Fast Pre-Config ID does not conflict with another unit

The sound is not synchronized with the video

Please adjust the PCR gap each time until you get the perfect A/V sync
